



## SALE OF CHAMETZ FORM

*The Torah prohibits ownership of chametz (leaven) during Pesach. Therefore, we arrange for the sale of chametz to a non-Jewish person. We make the transfer by appointing an agent, usually the rabbi, to handle the sale. It is a valid and legal transfer of ownership. At the end of the holiday, the agent arranges for return of the chametz to the original owner. Please return this form by Thursday, April 14. It is customary to make a donation which the Rabbi allocates those who need.*

***I/We authorize Rabbi Michael Klayman to sell our chametz on our behalf. Enclosed is a donation payable to the Rabbi's Discretionary Fund.***
